










Still Missing Children Data - May 2023







Child Safety Workshop conducted in Karachi

As part of our Missing Children Prevention Program, we regularly conduct child safety workshops in schools throughout Pakistan.

Our latest workshop was held at the People's School Malir in Karachi, operated by our partner organization Developments in Literacy (DIL). The workshop was attended by more than 80 children from class 6 till class 10.

The focus of the workshop was to educate students on child protection issues, especially online child abuse and online grooming, and to provide guidelines on how they can keep themselves safe from harm.




Differently abled lost child reunited with her family

11 year old differently abled girl Amina was found wandering the streets in Liaqatabad Market in Karachi during the night and the case was reported to us by one of our volunteers. Our field team immediately reached the girl and began searching for her family in the neighborhood and disseminating her picture on social media. Within a matter of hours, our team tracked down the family using a lead from nearby Ghousia Masjid and reunited them with their lost child.
